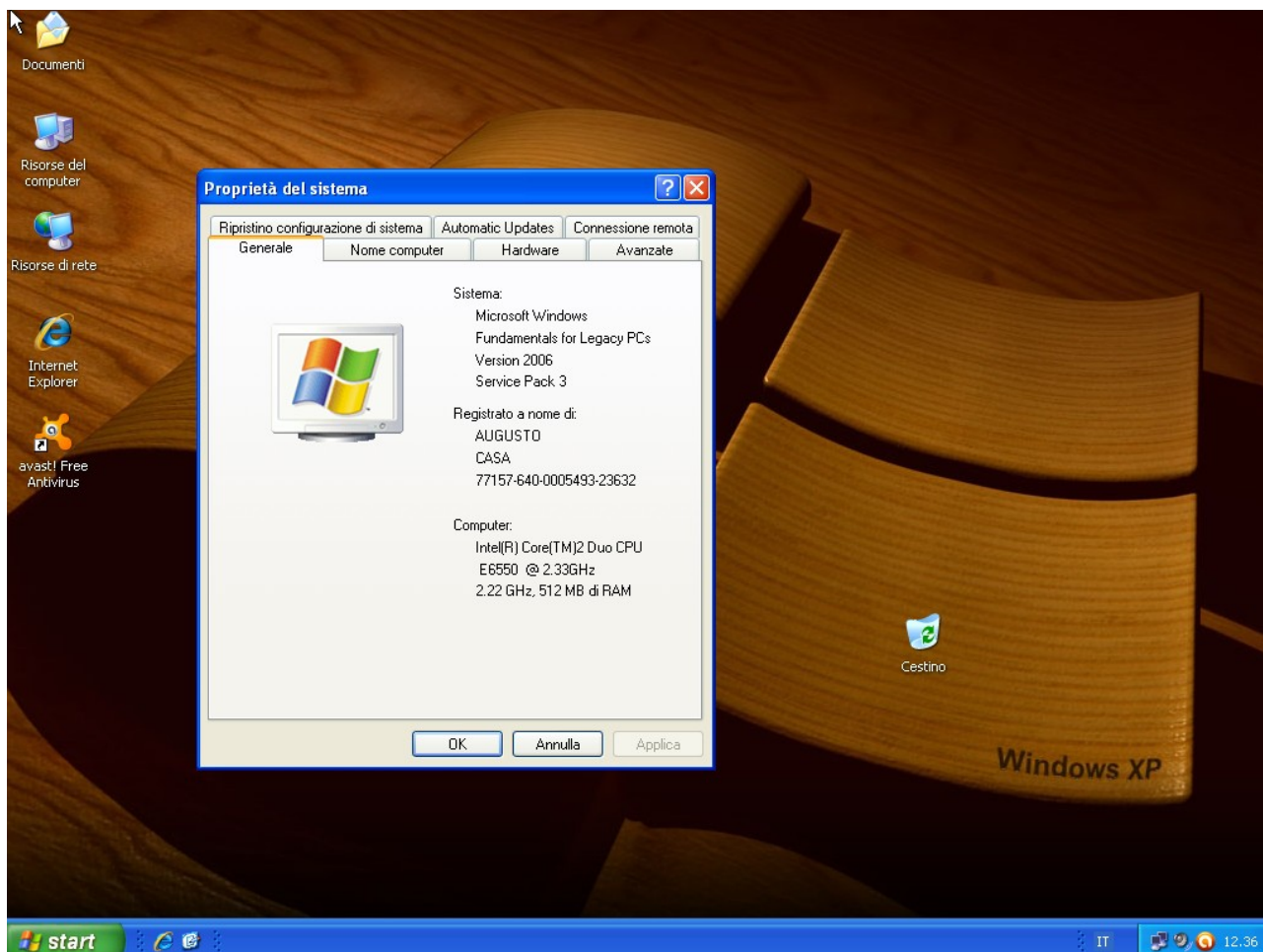

Mai visto in un negozio? Mai proposto da un rivenditore? Mai sentito parlarne?

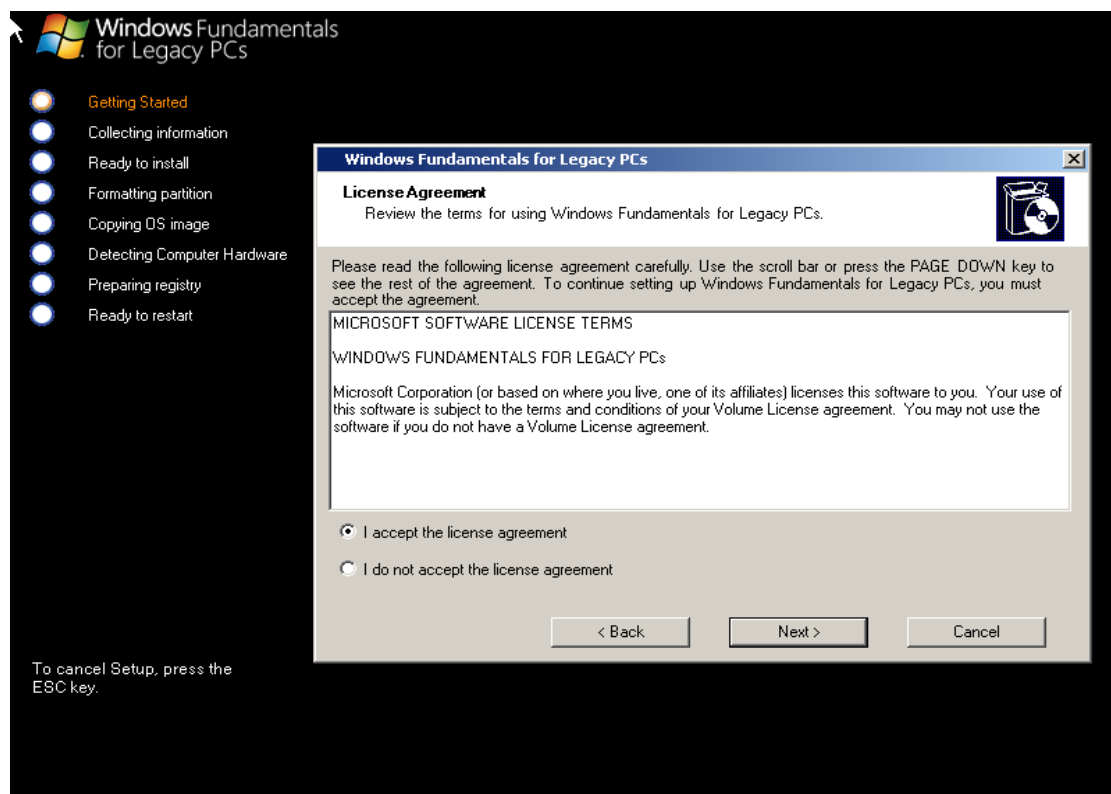
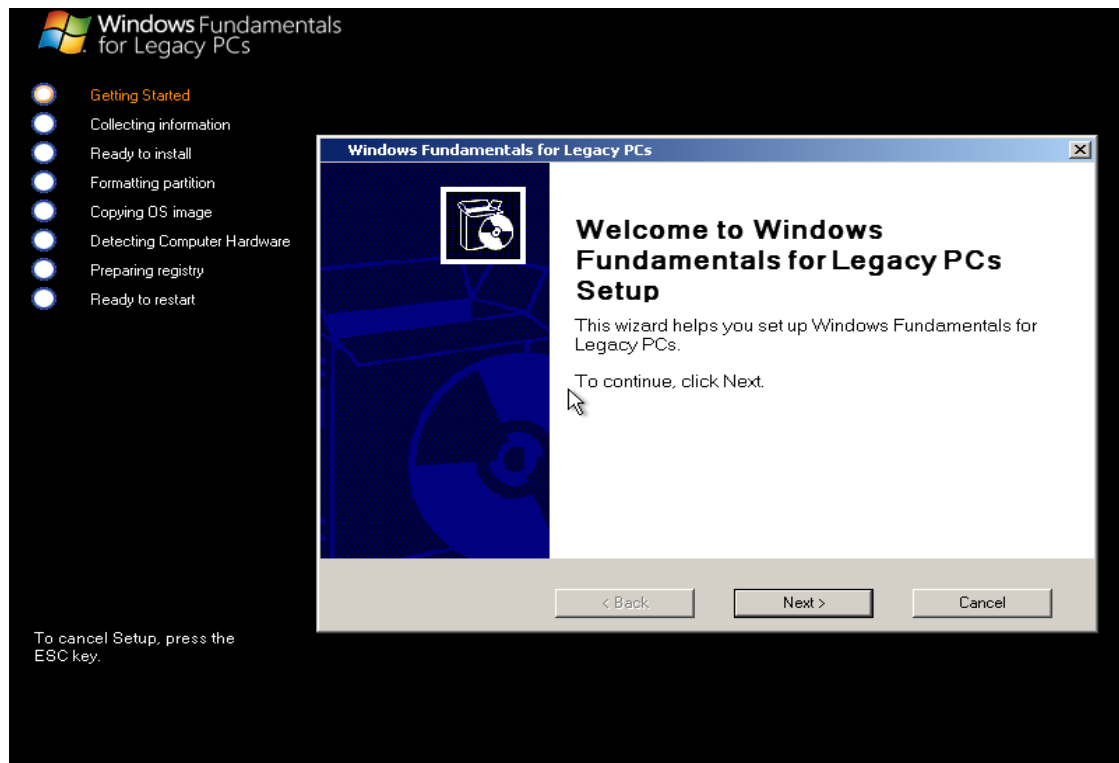

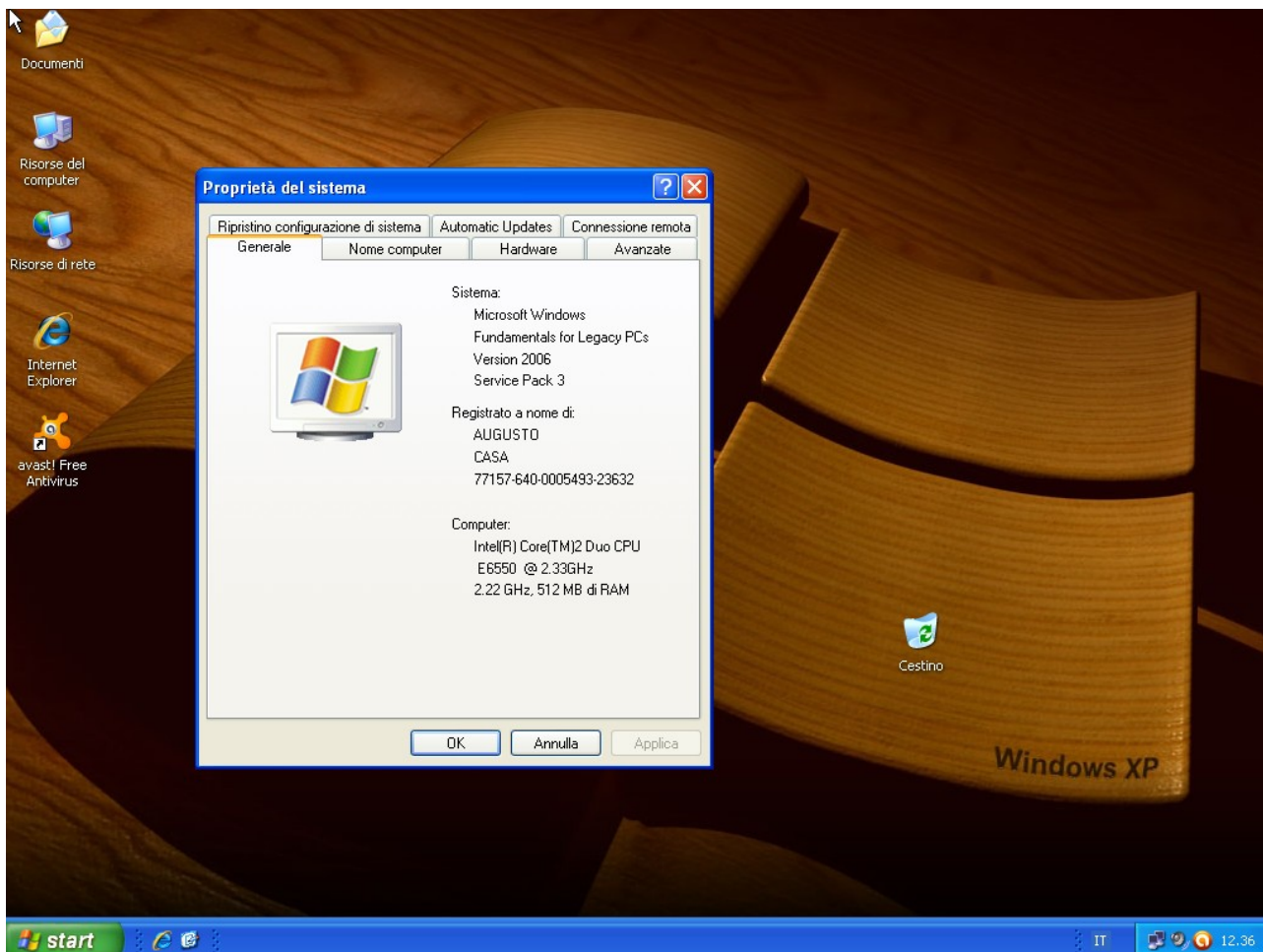
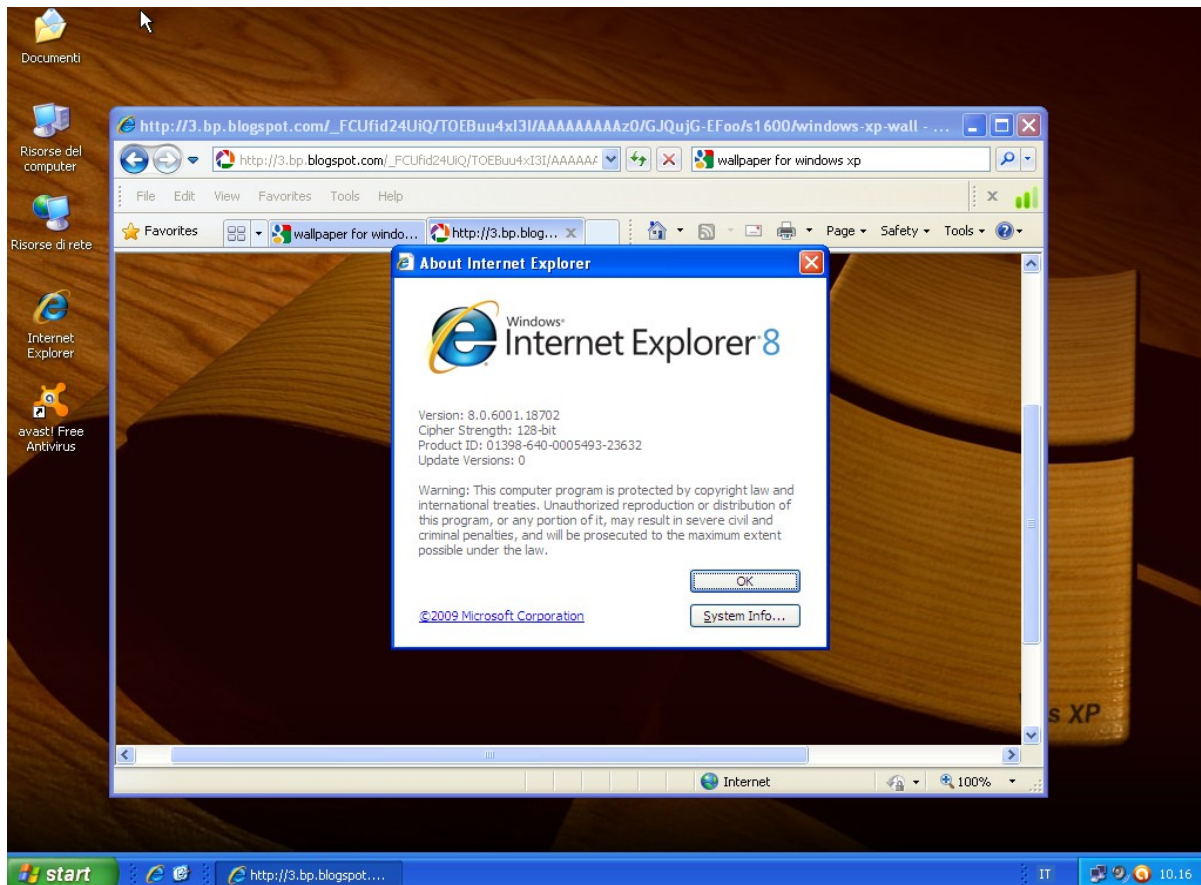


Ora abbiamo un Windows XP PRO SP3 in lingua italiana che gira velocissimo con soli 512 MB di RAM
